described in precise detail and clearly illustrated through color diagrams along with explanations of each point's actions, indications, and contraindications, honoring the traditional eastern roots of acupuncture in parallel with modern approaches of western medicine. This book is an essential resource for practitioners of all levels seeking to deepen their understanding of working with acupoints.
